NORTH ELEVATION

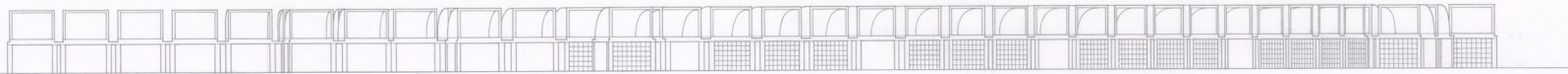




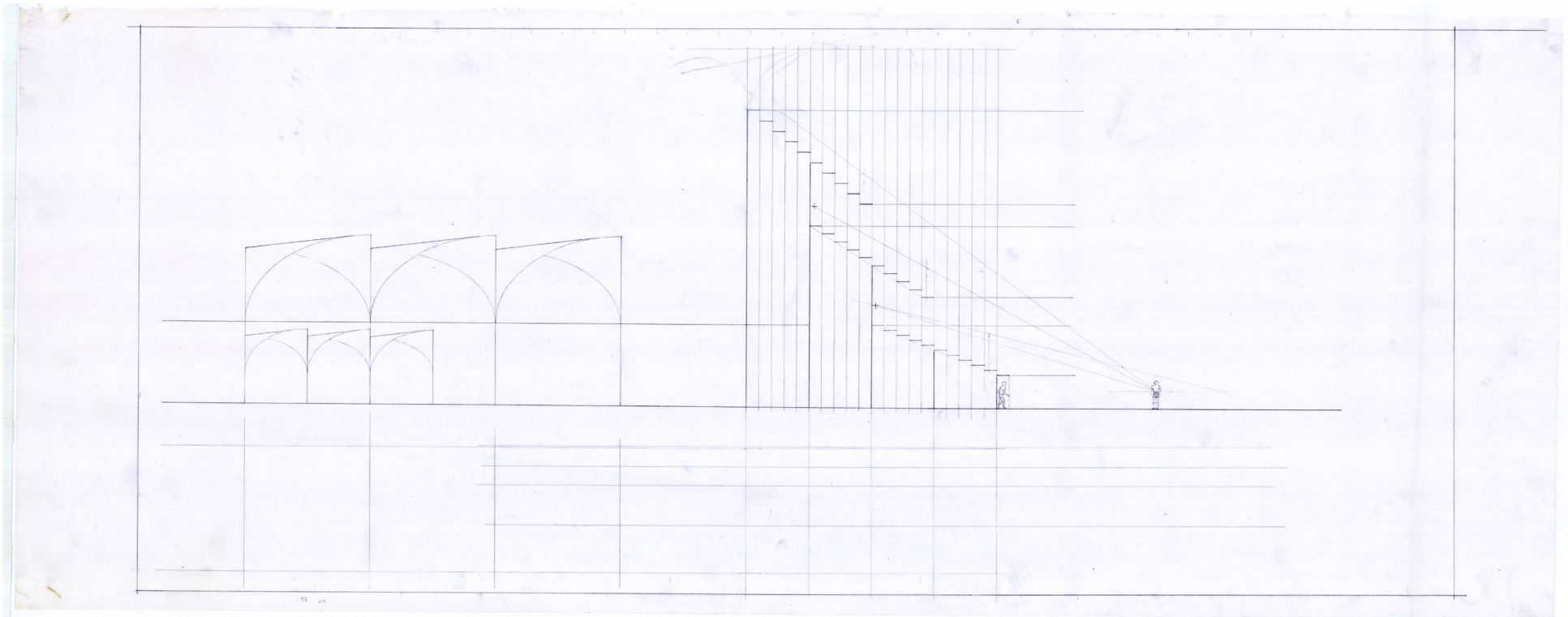


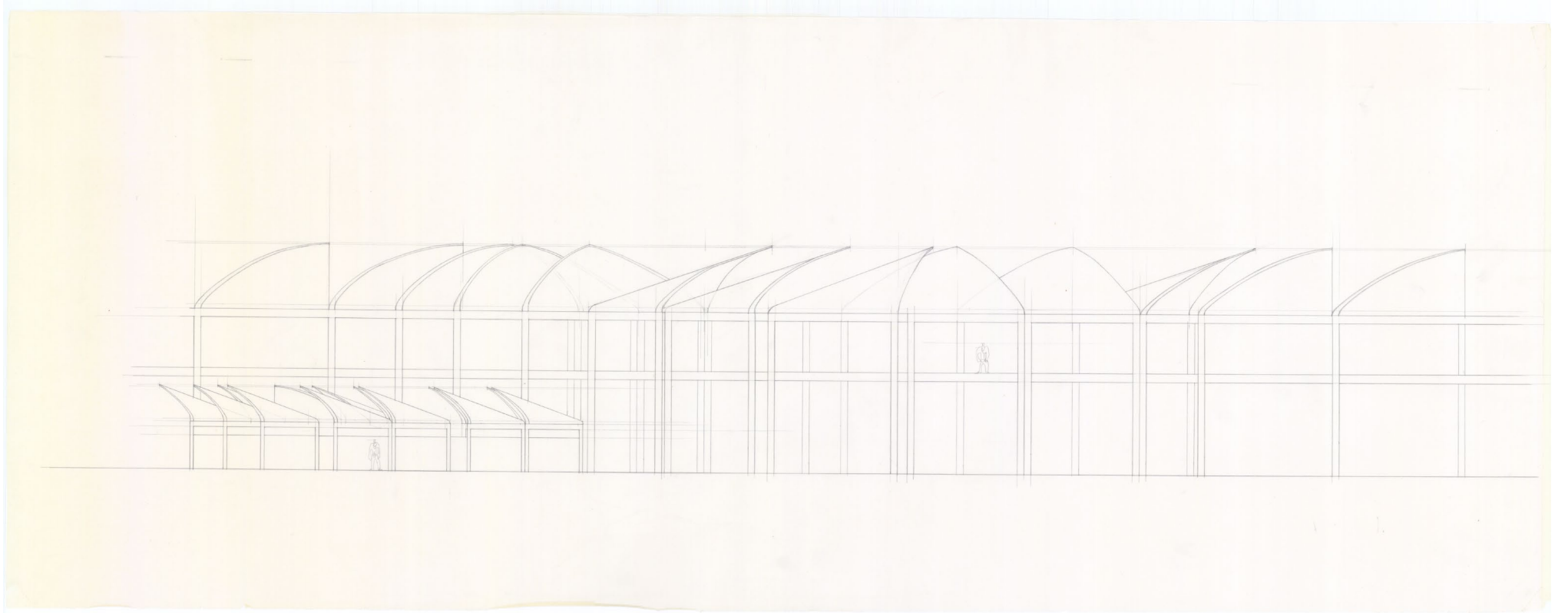


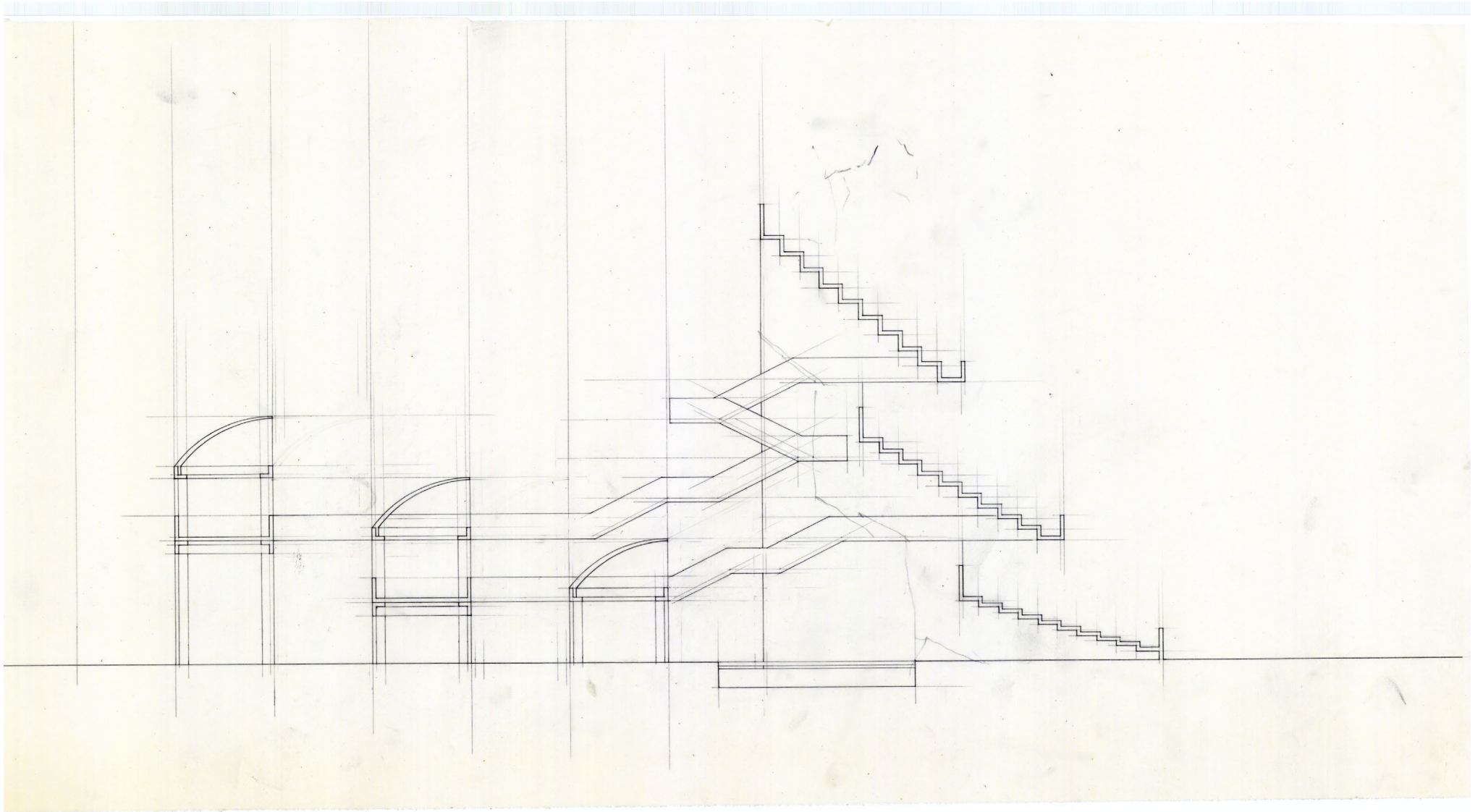


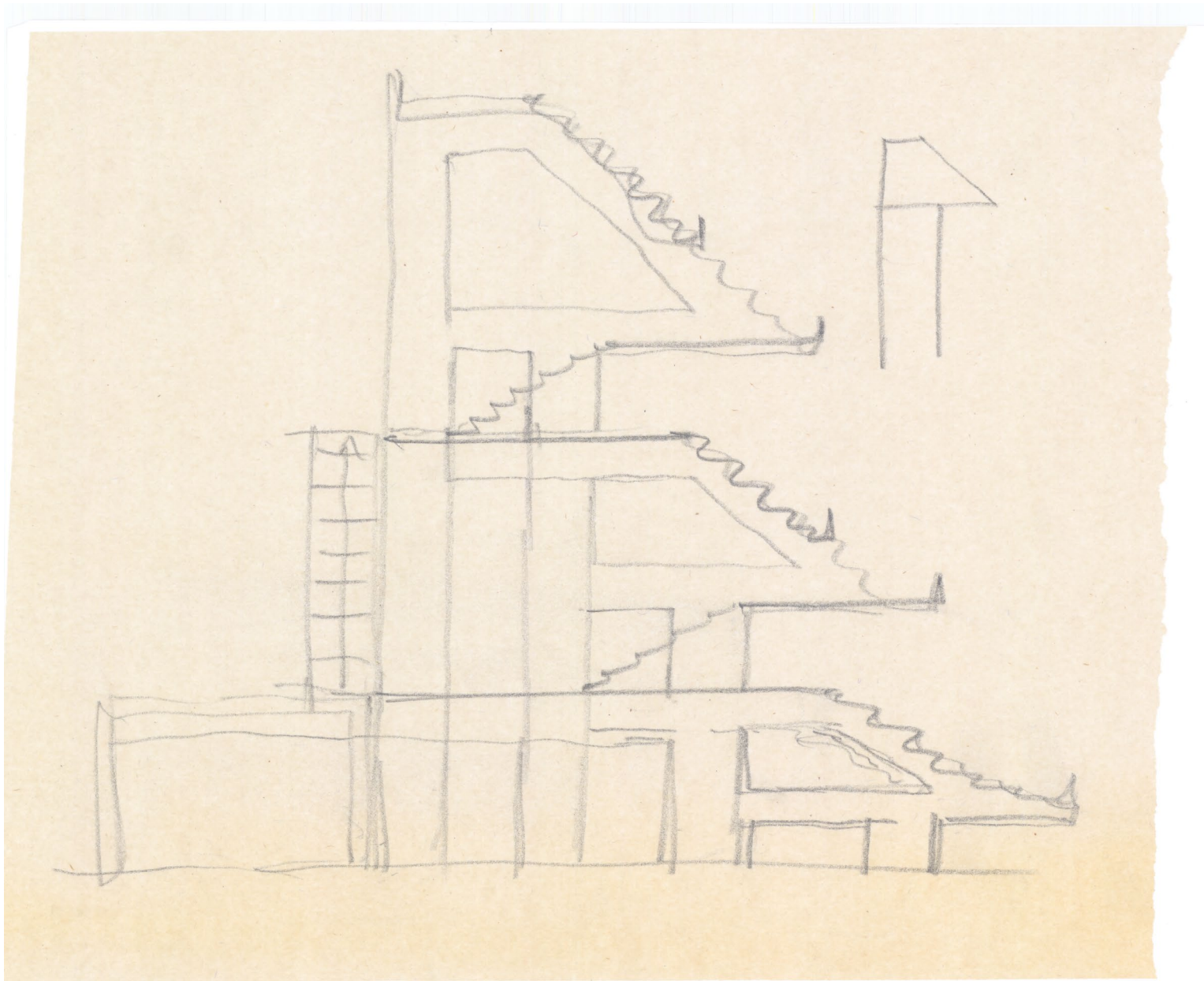
